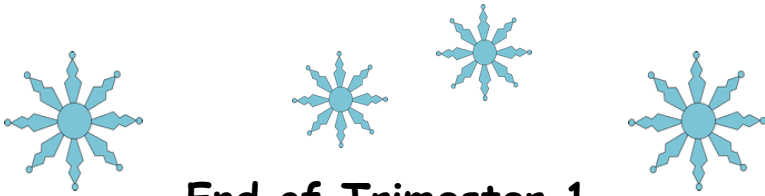


Mrs. Nielsen's MATH GROUP ☸ Songo Locks Elementary School ☸ 2014 - 2015



End of Trimester 1

Grading for the 1st trimester ended just before Thanksgiving Break. Teachers are currently working on report cards and they should go home on Friday, December 12th. Currently I recommend continuing practice of Multiplication Facts! Students will be expected to complete all basic multiplication facts in a timed test with 80% proficiency by the end of the 2nd trimester.

enVision Math
