## *Logging On To Schoology:*

<b>Go to the SLS Website:</b>	sls.lakeregionschools.org
<b>Click on the Student Link for</b>	Schoology (center of the top row)
<b>Login Using Your G-Mail Info:</b>	<a href="mailto:firstname.lastname@lakeregionschools.org">firstname.lastname@lakeregionschools.org</a>
<b>Password:</b>	first 2 letters first name & last name-lunch pin number ex. <b>kini1234</b> (Kimberly Nielsen 1234)
