## Attendance Counts

## Dress Code

We encourage students to take pride in their attire as it relates to the school setting. Students are to dress in a manner that, in addition to the following guidelines, takes into consideration the safety, health, and welfare of self and others, and does not disrupt the learning environment. Reminders:

1. **Tops must have two 2 inch straps or sleeves, must not be see through and must completely cover the midriff, sides, and back..**
2. Any garment worn should not expose the midriff or undergarments.
3. **Skirts and shorts** must be long enough to reach the middle of your child's thigh.
4. Pants, shorts, and skirts must be at the waist.
5. Sneakers are encouraged and required for students to be able to play on the playground equipment, as well as PE.
6. Students with **flip flops** pose a safety hazard and will not be permitted to play on the playground equipment.
