2. **Write Your Spelling Words in Many Ways:**

- a. On Index Cards
- b. On Paper
  - i. In pencil
  - ii. In pen
  - iii. In markers
  - iv. In crayons
  - v. In colored pencils
- c. On White Boards
- d. On Chalk Boards
- e. In a Pan of Dried Rice or Beans
- f. In Shaving Cream on a Cookie Sheet
- g. Using Rainbow Colors
- h. Color Consonants in One Color and Vowels in Another



3. **Build Your Spelling Words**

- a. Using Alphabet Letters
- b. Using Alphabet Blocks
- c. Using Alphabet Beads
- d. Using Dried Alphabet Soup
- e. Using String or Wicky Stix

4. **Understand Your Spelling Words**

- a. Sort them by Spelling Patterns
- b. Type your list on the Computer
- c. Look them up in the Dictionary
- d. Write them in Sentences
- e. Find the History of your Words

5. **Get Creative with Your Spelling Words**

- a. Illustrate your words
- b. Make a word search
- c. Play a game
- d. Create a comic strip using your words
- e. Act Them Out (like charades)
- f. Sign Them using ASL
